



Medieval Magic

Discover two stunning buildings right in the heart of Hexham offering you attractive and interesting venue options for your marriage ceremony.



At one time both the Old Gaol and the Moothall were part of a complex of buildings belonging to the Archbishop of York: The Moothall was used by his Bailiff to hold court and to entertain important guests, with the Old Gaol providing "accommodation".



The Moothall

On your wedding day, a ceremony in the Moothall will take place in the beautiful top floor Lockhart Room with its golden stone walls, grand fireplace and windows overlooking the market place below.



The former courtroom will be the reception room for your guests, and where they can be served a welcome drink on arrival and enjoy a sparkling toast to the bride and groom after the ceremony. Up to 60 guests can be accommodated. The dramatic stone staircase leading up to the entrance is a stunning backdrop providing the perfect spot for your wedding photography with lots of space for guests.

Hexham Old Gaol

Over 600 years old, the oldest purpose built prison in England is the perfect venue for an intimate wedding in a truly unique setting. With a choice of rooms available for the marriage ceremony up to 30 guests can be accommodated. This historic property is fully accessible.
